

Materials to support delivery and assessment for our qualifications

There are a number of documents available for our customers to use to support with the delivery of our new qualifications. These are available on the website under the Key Document and Course Materials tab for each qualification in Welsh and English.

Examples of these are:

Qualification Specification or Handbook

This document contains:

- The qualification content
- Details of what needs to be taught and assessed
- Information about qualification structure
- Centre requirements
- Assessment methodology and may also contain some administration information, as well as the units themselves.

Under the Supporting Information section of the units, there are lists of useful resources and references to legislation and policies, which are relevant to the unit content. This content can be used as source materials and further guidance for centre's qualification delivery resources.

Sample Assessment Materials

This document contains assessment examples, which have been written to the same level of content and based on the same criteria as the live assessments. They can be used in delivery of the qualifications to support learners to understand the level of demand expected of them to achieve their assessments.

Assessment Pack

The Assessment Pack contains an overview of the assessment methodology for the whole qualification **and** detailed guidance on how to plan and implement the assessment methods. The importance of employer involvement is also emphasised as well as good practice in teaching and learning. It also includes the recording forms to be used. This document should be used along with the **Qualification Delivery Guide**. The assessment pack includes a candidate brief to be given to the candidate when they are ready for assessment so they can work through each of the assessment tasks.

Qualification Delivery Guide

The purpose of the Qualification delivery Guide is to support assessors and managers to support candidates through their learning and assessment journey. This may also be useful to employers to raise their awareness of the qualifications and support them to identify where they can support learning and delivery.

Guidance for Teaching

The key aims of the **Guidance for Teaching** are to provide support to teachers in their delivery of the new WJEC GCSE in Health and Social Care, and Childcare specification and to offer guidance on the requirements of the qualification and the assessment process.

Assessment Resource Pack

This document contains all of the relevant recording forms for the qualification in Word format.

Student Guides are in development for the qualifications indicated below will be available during November/December 2019. The student Guides include a wealth of information, which will help support provide a thorough introduction to the qualifications.
